SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Higgins, then Senator Hoagland.

Unauthorized personnel, please leave the floor. We're looking for Senator Scofield, Senator DeCamp and Senator Haberman. Senator Haberman, would you record your presence, please. Senator Scofield. Thank you. Now we're looking for Senator DeCamp only. Okay, proceed, Senator Vickers, with your closing. Just a moment. (Gavel.) Could we have your attention? You're supposed to be in your seats, please, and we're listening to the closing on the kill motion.

SENATOR VICKERS: Thank you, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Excuse me, Senator Vickers. (Gavel.) Please hold your conversation down. It is just entirely too loud. Thank you.
