CLERK: 19 ayes, 23 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to indefinitely postpone the bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The motion lost. May I introduce some guests of Senator Harris, please. In the north balcony there are seven students from Irving Junior High in Lincoln and their teacher. Would you folks please stand and be recognized. Thank you. Nothing further on the bill, go back to the bill itself. Senator Rod Johnson, would you like to close, or I guess you're not closing.

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: Mr. President, I think debate has gone on long enough. I would just move that LB 204A be advanced to Select File.

SPEAKER NICHOL: A roll call has been asked for so we'll go on that. Please poke your green button. Senator Wesely. Senator Vard Johnson. He is here. Okay, a roll call vote and we're voting on the advancement of 204A Mr. Clerk.
