CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Lynch's amendment to the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The Lynch amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Hall.

SENATOR HALL: Mr. President, I'd move that LB 393 be advanced from Select File to E & R for Engrossment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: You've heard the motion. All those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. It is advanced. LB 157.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 157, the first item I have are E & R amendments, Senator.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Hall.

SENATOR HALL: Mr. President, I would move that the E & R amendments be adopted.

SPEAKER NICHOL: You have heard the motion. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. They are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a series of amendments to the bill. However, I also have a priority motion to bracket the bill until January 15, 1986. That motion is offered by Senators Haberman, Beyer, Pappas and Schmit.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Who is carrying the motion? Senator Beyer or Senator Pappas, do either one of you wish to take it? What page is that, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: It is a motion to bracket it, Senator.

SENATOR BEYER: Mr. Speaker and colleagues, I put my name on to bracket the bill. I think basically it is to give us some time to work out some details. I think probably we are as close to a solution on the whole situation and so with that I would urge that you vote to bracket this bill.
