

CLERK: 11 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Mr. President.

SENATOR LAMB: The house is under call. Unauthorized persons please leave the floor. All people check in, all legislators record your presence. While we're waiting for people to check in, we have a visitor under the south balcony, Troy James, son of Erma James who of course is an employee of Senator Carsten. This is part of his school government class. Troy, would you rise to be recognized by the Legislature. The house is under call. We're looking for Senator Hefner, Senator Rod Johnson, Senator Lynch, Senator Mathem. Senator Hefner, would you please record your presence. Senator Rod Johnson, please return to the legislative floor, the house is under call. We're still looking for Senator Hefner. All senators are present. Senator DeCamp, did you call for a roll call? Please call the roll, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken as found on page 2033 of the Legislative Journal.) 24 ayes, 22 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the amendment.

SENATOR LAMB: The motion fails. The amendment is not adopted. Do you have anything else on the bill, Mr. Clerk? The call is raised.

CLERK: Well, Mr. President, I have some motions. I have a motion to reconsider, however. Senator Hall would move to reconsider the vote on bracketing LB 157.

SENATOR LAMB: The Chair recognizes Senator Hall.

SENATOR HALL: Mr. President, members, I think it's fairly evident by the indecision on the part of body in the last two votes, those people being undecided, that the bill does need a lot of work. And the bracket motion is not intended to be a motion to kill the bill, just to give parties on both sides time to work things out. It will only be bracketed until January of next year. It will come back and be considered and put into place a year from now, but it will be a bill that will be worked out. I think right now we've got a bill that people aren't sure what is in it. They aren't sure what they are voting on and it's one of the reasons that there has been a lot of indecision. I would urge the body to bracket this bill until January of 1986. Thank you.
