

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Eret, would you like to close on your amendment, please.

SENATOR ERET: Yes, Mr. Speaker. I would just like to close by stating that I feel that if we did pass this amendment that we could get through this experimental phase with this form of taxation that Senator Johnson refers to and that I think we could quiet down the opposition that there has been out in the country. And we've had a lot of dissatisfaction through the county treasurers offices and I think if we would pass this it would make their life a lot more bearable when they meet the public on this issue. Thank you.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the adoption of the Eret amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Eret's amendment to the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The Eret amendment is adopted. Anything else?

CLERK: Yes, sir. Mr. President, the next amendment I have is by Senator Schmit. Senator, I understand you wish to withdraw yours. All right. Mr. President, Senator Vard Johnson would move to amend and that is on page 2018 of the Journal.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Vard Johnson.

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: Mr. Speaker, members of the body, the committee counsel has whispered sweet things in my ear which are, this is a technical amendment designed to deal with a subchapter S issue that we took care of in the bill. It changes a "which" to a "when" and it probably should have been done in E & R. It was not. I offer the amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the adoption of the Vard Johnson amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Vard Johnson's amendment to the bill.
