

\$10,000 in the striking of this ad valorem tax advisory commission and additionally in the, LB 271, the ag land valuation commission, remember that we have an advisory committee that we're creating there to advise the tax commissioner. We don't need two of them. This one has not been functioning well. It hasn't been able to have a quorum drawn or meet on a regular basis. It comes from a limited series of backgrounds for the people that serve on the commission as opposed to the broader based group of people that will serve on the ag land valuation task force advisory committee and for that reason this is a chance to stop ourselves from duplicating, save ourselves from a mechanism that really hasn't been working very well and also save \$10,000 with the doing away of the ad-valorem advisory commission.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Rogers, please.

SENATOR ROGERS: Mr. Speaker and members, I think Dave, Senator Landis, explained this very well. We have met with some of these people who are on the previous advisory committee and as Dave mentioned they do not meet. They cannot get a quorum and we will have this committee that will go along with 271 so I move for its adoption.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Vard Johnson.

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: Mr. Speaker, members of the body, having heard the eloquent remarks of Senator Landis and Senator Rogers and understanding the genesis of this request, I believe it should be adopted and I would support this amendment to LB 273.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Landis, did you wish to close or Senator Rogers? Okay. The question is the adoption of the Landis-Rogers amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, please.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Landis's and Rogers' amendment to the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: It is adopted.
