Now what we are doing here today, if you don't adopt Senator DeCamp's amendment, if we pass 271, we are doing it too quick, too fast, too much and it is far too complicated. Senator Landis was asked a question. He said, I will get you the answer after a while. The answers aren't here. Now I am not again criticizing the committee because there was a push-on to come up with a formula. Well, they came up with one and I will bet you \$5.00...we are not supposed to gamble, I would wager that I could make up a list of 25 questions on that formula and I could ask the members of this body what that means and to explain it and the answer would be, we will get you the answer later on. When? After 17 days and we are adjourned? Yes, that is when you get your answer, later on, later on, folks. Fine. If that is the way you want to do it, go right ahead, and that's the way Senator Johnson wants to do it.

SPEAKER NICHOL: One minute.

SENATOR HABERMAN: He says get it in there and make it complicated, mix it all up so they don't understand it and then when they go home, somebody will sit down and figure out what is going to be the best to raise the most money and they are going to disregard all the other issues that Amendment 4 had behind it, and, quite frankly, I'm scared. So I am just going to ask you to back up and take another look. It won't hurt it to wait another year. Thank you, Mr. President.
