LB 653, 653A

PRESIDENT: The first amendments were adopted pretty much in lieu of the original committee amendments.

SENATOR HIGGINS: All right, thank you.

PRESIDENT: Am I correct, Senator? The motion is the advancement of LB 653. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance 653, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced. Do you have anything for the record, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Yes, sir. There is an A bill on this one, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Oh, there is an A bill? Very well.

CLERK: Mr. President, A bill, 653A is a bill by Senator DeCamp. (Read title.)

PRESIDENT: Chairman DeCamp, we now have 653A before us.

SENATOR DECAMP: Mr. President, I don't think the A bill will ultimately be necessary. But rather than make a mistake it is an \$8,000 item. I would ask that the A bill be advanced. If it is not necessary, who knows what will happen.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion on 653A? The motion is to advance LB 653A. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. We are now voting on the appropriations bill to accompany 653, 653A. The motion is to advance 653A. Please record your vote. Please record your vote on the advancement of LB 653A. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on the motion to advance 653A.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced. Does the Clerk have matters to read into the record?
