I would simply go along with Senator Lundy's recommendation that we do have an interim study dealing with this problem. Because of our state laws counties have to come to this body to get permission for extra compensation, extra pension plans. Cities have that right. So we don't treat the bodies the same. So I think that we should look at this situation, but I think you should simply solve our problem first, and I hope that you will support this amendment. Thank you.
