SENATOR WARNER: If I am reading...if I am listening correctly and if I am reading correctly with the word of "or" if you had an axle that was 120 inches to the outside of the tires, the width of the building could be any width whatsoever as long as you use the word "or".

SPEAKER NICHOL: Just a moment.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion on the...

SPEAKER NICHOL: Just a minute, I haven't answered his question.

PRESIDENT: I'm sorry, I didn't mean to...I thought you were all finished.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay, we will amend it to "and" if you would like. It would be okay if we'd just have the Clerk change that.

SENATOR WARNER: All right.

SPEAKER NICHOL: All right. I appreciate your suggestion.
