SENATOR MARSH: A roll call vote has been requested.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 2086 of the Legislative Journal.) 25 ayes, 19 nays on the motion to reconsider, Mr. President.

SENATOR MARSH: We are now back and as I understand it the motion is not adopted. Twenty-five ayes, so it is...we are...we have reconsidered. The Haberman amendment, which was before us this morning, is now back before us. Senator Haberman.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Senator Hartnett, would you support the amendment if we took out the provision that was put in for garbage trucks?

SENATOR HARTNETT: Probably not.

SENATOR HABERMAN: What would it take, Senator Hartnett, for you to support the amendment?

SENATOR MARSH: Senator Haberman,...

SENATOR HABERMAN: I'm just trying to find out what the objections are.

SENATOR MARSH: Would you do that in person, please.
