

SENATOR MARSH: Senator Vard Johnson.

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: Mr. Speaker, this amendment was given to me, I'm sure, by the Fiscal Analyst. It reduces the A bill by \$3,000. I move the amendment, Madam President. You see every time you are in the Chair, Madam President, I can't remember what my amendments were and I've got to go look them up, and I get confused.

SENATOR MARSH: Seeing no lights, all those in favor of the adoption of the amendment which reduces the financial figure by \$3,000 vote aye, opposed no. This takes 25 votes. Senator Marsh voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Marsh voting yes.

SENATOR MARSH: The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 1 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the Vard Johnson amendment to the bill.

SENATOR MARSH: Senator Hall.

SENATOR HALL: Madam President, I would move that LB 201A be advanced from Select File to E & R for grossment.

SENATOR MARSH: You've heard the motion. All those in favor signify by saying aye. Opposed no. It is advanced. LB 439.

CLERK: Madam President, on 439 the first item I have are E & R amendments, Senator.

SENATOR HALL: Madam President, I would move the E & R amendments be adopted.

SENATOR MARSH: Those in favor of the E & R amendments vote aye...say aye. Opposed no. They are adopted.

CLERK: Madam President, the next amendment I have is offered by Senator Vickers. Senator Vickers's amendment is on page 1731 of the Journal.
