CLERK: Senator, I have E & R amendments on 102.

SENATOR HALL: Mr. President, I would move the E & R amendments be adopted.

SPEAKER NICHOL: You've heard the motion. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. They are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senators Schmit and Wesely would move to amend the bill. (See amendment found on page 2036 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Schmit, please.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, this amendment merely clarifies the fact that if the cost of maintenance and operation of a project should exceed...bring the total cost above \$10 million that the project can still be financed from the resource development fund. I think it is very apparent there is no money in the water management fund, so I don't expect a hell of a lot coming out of that. But I want to be sure that you understood that we weren't robbing the bank and that we're only going to get money to the extent of \$10 million, no more, for this kind of project. I move the adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Any further discussion? If not, the question is the adoption of the Schmit amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Voting on the adoption of the Schmit amendment, please. For those of you who care to, please vote promptly so we can move along. Thank you. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Schmit's amendment to the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The Schmit amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill.
