

SENATOR HANNIBAL: Okay...

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...but it prohibits putting into the trust fund, on an annual basis, general funds.

SENATOR HANNIBAL: Does it prohibit putting general funds in on an annual basis, or does it prohibit having any funds placed under this appropriation this year?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Or does it prohibit...

SENATOR HANNIBAL: Are you prohibiting funds going in there ever, or are you saying there shall be no funds from the general fund placed in that program under this \$200,000 appropriation?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Yes, what I'm saying is that \$200,000 general appropriation is all that is going to be used for that particular program. There is not going to be any build up in the trust fund,...

SENATOR HANNIBAL: Okay...

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...unless there is money in the trust fund from other than general funds, from federal government or from private sources, whatever.

SENATOR HANNIBAL: So what you are doing is taking the \$200,000 general fund appropriation into the program this year, no funds staying there to accrue for that purpose from the general fund.

SENATOR BEUTLER: That's right.

SENATOR HANNIBAL: You are allowing federal funds to accrue to the program if they qualify. You are allowing private funds to accrue to the program if they so desire.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Exactly.

SENATOR HANNIBAL: But what you have done, I believe, though is you have eliminated any federal funds that would come into this program if there was a match requirement. Is that correct?
