SPEAKER NICHOL: The house is under call. Will you please record your presence. Those not in the Chamber, please return to the Chamber and record your presence. How many are excused, Mr. Clerk? Six are excused. Those members not in the Chamber, please return quickly so we can conclude the day. Thank you. Looking for Senator Chronister, Senator Conway, Senator Eret, Senator Goodrich, Senator Goll, Senator Harris, Senator Labeledz, Senator Lamb, Senator Lynch. Still looking for Senator Lamb, Senator Goodrich, Senator Eret, Senator Chronister and Senator Labeledz. I believe we're all here now. Did you ask for a roll call vote, Senator Beutler? Yes. Okay. Roll call vote. We are voting on the Beutler amendment to the Warner amendment. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 2099-2100 of the Legislative Journal.) 13 ayes, 26 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The amendment to the amendment fails. I understand you have another amendment to the amendment. Okay, we are back to the Warner amendment. Senator Warner, did you wish to say anything further about your amendment?

SENATOR WARNER: Oh, there is an amendment, I guess, Mr. President.
