CLERK: 27 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Warner's amendment to the bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: It is adopted. I understand you have one more amendment.

CLERK: Actually I have two motions, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay.

CLERK: Senator Lynch would move to amend. (See Lynch amendment found on pages 2100-04 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Lynch.

SENATOR LYNCH: Mr. President, members, I know it is late but this shouldn't take but just a minute. At one time when you took out your marriage license you spent \$25, \$15 of that went towards the VD test. That has been eliminated. I think we are all concerned along with Senator Warner and the members of the Revenue Committee as to when we spend money how do we make money at the same time to replace the fund so that we can afford to carry out these worthwhile causes. I have an amendment that will raise fees, marriage license fees from \$10 to \$20, delayed birth certificate fee from \$5 to \$6, certificate of birth for adopted parents from \$5 to \$6, and a new certificate of birth from \$5 to \$6. We estimate this will raise about 190 some thousand dollars. I offer this in very good faith and hope you will seriously consider it and at the same time realize that this will, in fact, be less in total than what we were spending just a year or two ago on marriage licenses alone. I think it is worthwhile, and I think it is an appropriate way to raise the funds for this particular purpose. All of these fees directly affect and are affected by people who are, basically, and I think very seriously concerned with this kind of a very worthwhile effort. So I would humbly ask for your support for this amendment.
