SENATOR BEUTLER: How many are excused, Mr. President?

PRESIDENT: Five. Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Well, I'd ask for a roll call vote and take call in votes. I guess I would take call in votes, a call of the house and call in votes, please.

PRESIDENT: We are all present under Final Reading. We'll either take call in votes or roll call. Check in please, members of the Legislature, to show your presence. Simulated roll call as we're under a call of the house. We are on Final Reading. Technically all unexcused members are to be in your seats. Please check in and show your presence. Please...okay, Senator Hannibal, hi. Senator Hartnett, you rascals, check in please. Senator Vickers. Senator Chronister. Senator Labedz. Senator Marsh. Okay, we are all here who are not excused so do you wish to call in votes? Members may call in your vote to the Clerk if you have not voted or wish to vote. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Senator Beutler. A roll call vote has been requested. Proceed with the roll call, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken as found on pages 2118-19 of the Legislative Journal.) 20 ayes, 24 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion fails. Is there anything further on the bill, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The Chair would announce that Senator Hall has 24 eighth grader guests in the south balcony from Assumption School in Omaha accompanied by their teacher.
