

problems. The technical problems, I think, because the bill goes into effect in January, will result in a bit of chaos at the courthouses and in the same type of reaction we have had on two or three other matters where the county clerks or the county treasurers in this case will say, we will blame the Legislature for all the mix-up or the problems, and I rather suspect that when this bill passes about January 15th or January 20th of next year, we will have an emergency bill in here with an emergency clause to correct what defects are going to be discovered. I am not going to go into those now other than to say administratively I think you have got serious problems in the bill even if the bill were perfect. However, my good seatmate, Senator Conway, has asked me not to attempt to kill the bill or amend it. I suggested, for example, delaying the implementation date to maybe July of next year so you would have time to make any corrections, some other things. He doesn't want me to do that. And as everybody in this body knows, there is a certain relationship develops between seatmates and you know that maybe next time on some bill that might be the guy you kind of tap on the shoulder and beg for a vote when you are sitting on 24 and whether we like to admit it or not it is really true. So all I will do is say I don't think you should vote for the bill if you were wise, but I am going to cease any attempts to amend my good seatmate's bill and predict that you will be here in January, if you pass the bill, about the 20th of January when they discover how it works with an emergency bill and a lot of mad people out there. With that said, I would withdraw the amendment.
