LB 408

SENATOR LABEDZ: Thank you, Mr. President. I agree with Senator Johnson. I did receive some calls from the smaller bingo operators saying that it would be difficult for them to compete with the prizes, and if we keep it at a lower amount, I'm sure that it will be satisfactory to all, and even with that, I believe Senator Johnson is putting a slight increase in there on prize money in the total amount and the total proceeds. So I highly support the amendment on LB 408.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion on Senator Johnson's motion? Any closing, Senator Johnson?

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: No closing, Mr. Speaker.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to return LB 408 to Select File for a specific amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? The Clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on Senator Vard Johnson's motion to return the bill.

PRESIDENT: The motion prevails. Senator Johnson.

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: Mr. Speaker, I will now move the amendment as previously discussed.

PRESIDENT: The motion is debatable. Is there any discussion on the motion offering the amendment to the bill? If not, please vote aye or nay on the motion to amend the bill. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 34 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Johnson's amendment to the bill.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted. Do you wish to readvance the bill, Senator?

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: I move it be returned to E & R engrossing.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to return the bill from Select File to E & R for engrossment. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. The motion carried. The bill is readvanced.
