Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Beutler's amendment.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted. Senator Beutler, would you readvance the bill.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Would move that the bill be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to advance the bill from Select File to E & R for engrossment. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. The motion carried. The bill is readvanced. Anything further on the bill?

CLERK: No, sir, nothing further.

PRESIDENT: Read LB 112 then.

CLERK: (Read LB 112 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 112 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Please record your vote on the final passage of LB 112. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote as found on page 2123 of the Legislative Journal.) 32 ayes, 11 nays, 5 excused and not voting, 1 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 112 is declared passed. LB 216.

CLERK: (Began reading LB 216 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: There is an amendment on the desk I guess.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator DeCamp would move to return the bill. (Amendment appears on page 1525 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator DeCamp.
