LB 372, 382, 713

If you fine group of students would stand, we'd like to acknowledge your presence and welcome you to the Nebraska Legislature. The Chair would like to warn the students that are at the front of the seating, do not lean over the bannister, please, it is quite dangerous. The Clerk will proceed to read LB 372 on Final Reading.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 372 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 372 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. You are voting on final passage of LB 372. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read as found on page 2126 of the Legislative Journal.) 43 ayes, 0 nays, 4 excused and not voting, 2 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 372 is declared passed. (Gavel.) The Chair notes that we are in some disorder. We are on Final Reading and members are to be in your seats before we proceed with the next bill. Read LB 382, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read LB 382 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 382 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read as found on page 2127 of the Legislative Journal.) 44 ayes, 0 nays, 4 excused and not voting, 1 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 382 is declared passed. Do you have matters to read into the record at this time, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: No, sir, I do not.

PRESIDENT: Then we proceed to the special order item on the agenda, LB 713.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 713 was introduced by the Business and Labor Committee and signed by its members. (Title read.) The bill was read on January 22 of this year. It
