

PRESIDENT: Yes, simple majority. All those in favor of the DeCamp amendment to the committee amendments vote aye, opposed vote nay. Please record your vote on the DeCamp amendment to the committee amendments. Have you all voted? Please record your vote. Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Chairman, I would ask for everybody...are we under call?

PRESIDENT: We are under call.

SENATOR BEUTLER: I would ask for everybody to check in and for a roll call vote.

PRESIDENT: I think other than Senator Chizek we are all here. Do they have any report on Senator Chizek? Okay, is it all right to proceed with the roll call vote without checking in and we are all...

SENATOR BEUTLER: I think I would like to have Senator Chizek here if he is not excused.

PRESIDENT: He is not excused but we cannot locate him.

SENATOR BEUTLER: I am sorry, Mr. President, this is too important to...

PRESIDENT: Very well. Sergeant-at-Arms, I guess we are going to have to see if we can find Senator Chizek, and members will please stay in your seats, we are under house call rules, call of the house rules. If Senator Chizek, or anyone knows about Senator Chizek and is within hearing...here we are, here we are. Senator Chizek is here and we are all here who are not excused and Senator Beutler has asked for a roll call. Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Would you reverse the roll, Mr. Speaker, please.

PRESIDENT: Roll call has been requested in reverse order and the Clerk will proceed. You will maintain your silence so that your vote may be heard. Proceed, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read the roll call vote as found on page 2128 of the Legislative Journal.) 21 ayes, 19 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the amendment.
