SENATOR HABERMAN: All right, then the...all right, thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR WARNER: Certainly.

PRESIDENT: The Chair would interrupt debate to announce that Senator Marsh has 18 student guests in the south balcony. They are from Lincoln Christian School and among them is Chris Carsten, a grandson of Senator Carsten, and they are accompanied by their teacher, and we would like to have you stand, and we want to recognize you and thank you for coming over to see your Nebraska Legislature this morning. Is there further discussion on the amendment that Senator Warner is offering? If not, the motion is to adopt the amendment offered by Senator Warner to LB 721. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of the Appropriations Committee amendment to the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted. Next on the desk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senators Hefner, Conway, and Schmit would move to amend the bill. That amendment is on page 2006 of the Journal.

PRESIDENT: Senator Hefner, are you spokesman for that group? Senator Chronister is busy.

CLERK: 2006, Senator. It is district courts and statewide probation.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Hefner.

SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. President and members of the body, I apologize for not being ready for this. This transfers some funds that was used last year when we had to provide service up in northeast Nebraska, and this was when former Judge Kneifl was removed from the bench, and this amendment is on 2006, and I would urge the adoption of this.
