LB 271A, 273A, 715A

CLERK: No, sir, I do not.

PRESIDENT: Then we will proceed to Select File. LB 271A
The call of the house is raised.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have no amendments on 271A.

PRESIDENT: Senator Hall, do you want to move to advance the
bill?

SENATOR HALL: I move that LB 271A be advanced from Select
File to E & R for Engrossment.

PRESIDENT: You heard the motion to advance the bill. All
those in favor say aye. Opposed no. Motion carried.
LB 271A is advanced. LB 273A.

CLERK: 273, Senator, I have no amendments to the bill.

PRESIDENT: Senator Hall.

SENATOR HALL: Mr. President, I move that LB 273A be
advanced from Select File to E & R for Engrossment.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion to advance. All those
in favor say aye. Opposed no. Motion carried. The
bill is advanced. 715A.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have no E & R amendments. However,
I do have an amendment from Senator Vard Johnson which will
be handled by Senator Landis.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Landis, and may we
have order in the Chamber please. (Gavel.) And the Chair
would remind all that Final Reading is coming up very
shortly so we don't want to lose our membership. Senator
Landis.

SENATOR LANDIS: Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature,
the Revenue Committee put the administrative costs incumbent
in a change in the way we handle the LB 3 refunds in both
715A and 273. It is about \$55,000. This amendment takes
that money out of the A bill, and for that reason, I would
move its adoption. It is simply the undoing of a duplicate
two-track system, and so that we will have that money but we
