CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Vard Johnson would move to amend the bill. Senator Johnson's amendment is on page 1634 of the Journal.

PRESIDENT: Who is handling Senator Johnson's amendment? Senator Vard Johnson, are you in the area. Senator Vard Johnson, you have an amendment up on the floor. Is Senator Johnson's office listening to our broadcast this morning. Senator Vard Johnson, if you are within hearing distance, you have a motion pending in the Legislature. LB 632, Senator.

CLERK: Senator, your amendment is on page 1634.

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature, the amendment that I am offering on page, whatever it is, is one that would increase the ADC allowance from \$300 a month to \$315 a month and I believe that the fiscal note that would be applied to that amendment is in the neighborhood of \$2 million, and I have decided that probably as the better part of discretion given our budgeting situation that at this time I should not offer the amendment. So for that reason, I ask leave to withdraw the amendment.

PRESIDENT: Thank you, Senator Johnson. The amendment is withdrawn.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Hall.

SENATOR HALL: Mr. President, I move that LB632 be advanced from Select File to E & R for Engrossment.

PRESIDENT: Senator Johnson.

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: I think I want to speak on this if I could.

PRESIDENT: Very well.
