Beutler, Senator Remmers, please record your presence. Senator Higgins, record your presence. Senator Landis, Schmit, Hoagland. Senator Hoagland, Senator Landis, Senator Schmit, Senator DeCamp. Senator Landis, the house is under call. Please report to the Chamber. Did you want call in votes, Senator Vard. Very well. Senator Landis at the present time is the only one we are not finding.

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: We are not finding Senator Landis.

PRESIDENT: We are looking for him.

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: We should locate Senator Landis I suspect.
