LB 608A, 633

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Vickers on an amendment to LB 633.

SENATOR VICKERS: Mr. President and members, the amendment, and I just apologize for not having a copy for everybody, I just now got it, what it does, it is a clean-up amendment to the section of the statutes that was not stricken with the passage of 259 a couple of years ago, and the Revisor of Statutes tells me that they could do it with a revisor bill this next year but it is causing some problems, some technical problems in some of the school districts this year, so instead of waiting for next year for a revisor's bill, I would urge the adoption of this amendment to change the statute numbers in a couple of places that should have been changed with a bill a couple of year's ago. So I urge the adoption of this amendment, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: (Gavel.) Is there discussion on the amendment offered by Senator Vickers? If not, the motion is to adopt the amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. You are voting on the Vickers amendment to LB 633 on Select File. Please record your vote. May we have your cooperation on the matter before us, the adoption of an amendment offered by Senator Vickers. Please record your vote on an amendment to 633. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Vickers amendment to the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted. Senator Hall. Anything else on it, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Hall.

SENATOR HALL: Mr. President, I would move that the bill, 633, be advanced from Select File to E & R for Engrossment.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion to advance the bill. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. Motion carried. The bill is advanced. LB 608A.

CLERK: 608A, Senator, I have nothing on the bill.
