LB 608A, 612

PRESIDENT: Senator Hall.

SENATOR HALL: I would move that LB 608A be advanced from Select File to E & R for Engrossment.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to advance 608A. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. Motion carried. The bill is advanced. Now then LB 333, are the people finished with the preparation of that? Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. President, Senator Barrett and myself are getting together on some revised amendments to that, and rather than dispute the amendment on the floor, we are trying to work out something that might be acceptable to he and to I and to everyone. So we don't have it, probably after the lunch hour.

PRESIDENT: Senator Barrett requested that it be taken care of after lunch, if the Speaker's agenda will allow us to go on Select File after lunch to handle that one bill. Very well. May we move to anything for the record as yet, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: No, sir.

PRESIDENT: We will move on to General File at ten minutes till twelve, 612.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 612 was a bill that was introduced by Senators Schmit and Hannibal. (Read title.) It has been considered by the Legislature, Mr. President, on May 2nd of this year, committee amendments were adopted. There was an amendment by Senator Hoagland to the bill that was adopted. I now have pending an amendment by Senator Hannibal to the bill.

PRESIDENT: All right, we have a pending amendment by Senator Hannibal and the Chair would like to announce first that Senator Goll has guests in the north balcony. They are 50 fourth graders from Tekamah-Herman Elementary School in Tekamah, Nebraska, Burt County, with their teacher. We welcome you to the Legislature.
