Senator Schmit and Senator Hefner. All members please record your presence for us now, the house is under call. Senator Harris please. Senator Scofield please. Senator Schmit and Senator Hefner, your presence is requested in the Legislative Chamber. Sergeant-at-Arms will check again on the whereabouts of Senators Hefner and Schmit. Senators Hefner and Schmit, please come to the Chamber. The house is under call. Senator Barrett, do you want to proceed without Senators Hefner and Schmit? Go ahead, then. The Clerk will call the roll. Members, please maintain silence please. Aye or nay.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 2186 of the Legislative Journal.) 21 ayes, 13 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The bill fails to advance. Now we go into General File, unless you have some matters to put into the record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: I do, Mr. President.
