

PRESIDENT: Call of the house has been requested. The question is, shall the house come under call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 9 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries and the house is under call. All members sitting here in the Legislature, please look up to the green board and record your presence. Would you please record your presence on the green board, please. The house is under call. All members outside the Chamber, please return to the Legislative Chamber, the house is under call. The board wasn't working a while ago, would you please check in again. Check in and record your presence, members. Those of you who are sitting in your seats, those of you who are in the Chamber, please record your presence. Members outside the Legislative Chamber, please return, the house is under call. The motion before us is an amendment by Senator Lamb to the committee amendments on the court redistricting bill. Members, please check in. Senator Rupp, Senator Schmit, Senator Lynch, Senator Hannibal, Senator Baack, Senator Goll, Senator Goodrich, Senator Beyer, Senator Richard Peterson, Senator Rogers, Senator Hoagland. Senator Schmit, Senator Vickers, DeCamp, presence, please. Senator Emil Beyer. Senator Beyer, turn your green light on, please. Senator Lynch, please record your presence. Senator Vickers, Senator Hoagland. Senator Hoagland, I guess we are looking for you. There you are. That's all. This represents our full complement of membership this morning not excused. Senator Lamb, you may proceed. Senator Lamb, we have completed a call of the house and all unexcused members are on the floor. Members are to be in your seats during call of the house. (Gavel.)
