SENATOR LAMB: Mr. President...

PRESIDENT: Yes.

SENATOR LAMB: ...are all the members on the floor that are not excused?

CLERK: (Read the roll call vote as found on pages 2199-2200 of the Legislative Journal.) 18 ayes, 21 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is not adopted. The Chair would announce that Senator Morehead has guests under the...well, I better wait for them to arrive. Here they are. Can't see you for the lights. Senator Morehead has 7 seventh and eighth graders from Fairbury Christian School at Fairbury in the south balcony. These eighth graders are accompanied by their teachers.
