SENATOR HOAGLAND: I would like a call of the house, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Very well. A call of the house has been requested. The question is, shall the house come under call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 12 ayes, 0 nays to go under call.

PRESIDENT: The house is under call. You may call in your votes to the Clerk. The motion standing is the motion to cease debate on the indefinite postponement motion. You may call in your vote to the Clerk if you wish to vote on the motion to cease debate. All members of the Legislature outside the Chamber, please return to the Chamber. The house is under call. Who is sitting...Senator Conway, please record your presence.

CLERK: Senator Chronister voting yes.

PRESIDENT: Members may call in your presence...call in your vote to the Clerk on the motion to cease debate.

CLERK: Senator Labeledz voting yes. Senator Higgins voting yes.

PRESIDENT: (Microphone not on)...motion to cease debate. Shall the debate cease? Aye or nay. Call in your vote to the Clerk.

CLERK: I have enough, Governor.

PRESIDENT: Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays to cease debate.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries. The debate is closed and Senator Lamb has the opportunity to formalize the closing.

SENATOR LAMB: Well, Mr. President and members, I ask you to kill this bill now.

PRESIDENT: May we have order in the Chamber, please?
