But this is why we continue to use that. I think that Senator Sieck's amendment to our committee amendment is a good one. He just adds "possess or" transport alcoholic liquors. Of course, it already is illegal to consume alcoholic beverages but I think the law enforcement people need this bill and I commend Senator Sieck for bringing it to our committee and to also the Legislature. So the committee amendments do become the bill now and I would urge you to support it.
