

CLERK: Senator Lamb voting yes. Senator Lynch voting no. Senator Warner voting no. Senator Scofield voting no.

SPEAKER NICHOL: We need Senator DeCamp. Senator Hoagland, record your presence, please. Thank you. We need Senator Marsh, Senator Wesely, Senator Morehead. Senator Smith, please record your presence. Thank you.

CLERK: Senator Carsten voting yes.

SPEAKER NICHOL: For those that have come in, we are voting on the adoption of the committee amendments and call in votes are acceptable.

CLERK: Senator Vard Johnson voting yes. Senator DeCamp voting yes. Senator Lowell Johnson voting yes.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 5 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The call is raised. The committee amendments are adopted as amended. Now we are on the bill.

SENATOR SIECK: Mr. President and members of the body...
