SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Marsh, then Senator Pirsch, then Senator...

SENATOR MARSH: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. I plan to vote against the kill motion. I do not want drinking drivers to be able to drink and drive with impunity. I want to have legislation on our books so that there is a legitimate reason to encourage people not to drink and drive in a vehicle. We can keep on thinking of all kinds of what if. I do not think this is the wisest direction for us to go. I will vote against the kill motion.
