

SPEAKER NICHOL: The house is under call. Please return to your desks and record your presence. All those not in the Legislative Chamber, please return and record your presence. Three are excused. So please record your presence promptly. Please record your presence. Thank you. Senator Marsh, Senator Warner, Senator Higgins, Senator Pappas, Senator Lynch. We are looking for Senator Warner and Senator Goodrich. Senator Vickers.

SENATOR VICKERS: Are we ready? Is that all the ones that aren't excused, Mr. President?

SPEAKER NICHOL: We are only looking for Senator Warner now and then we will be ready to take the vote.

SENATOR VICKERS: Why don't you call the roll in reverse order, if you will, please.

SPEAKER NICHOL: All right. Okay to go ahead now, Senator Vickers? (Gavel.) If I could have your attention a moment, please.

SENATOR VICKERS: Wait till Warner gets here if he is coming, please.

SPEAKER NICHOL: All right, as soon as Senator Warner gets here we are going to vote on the Vickers amendment. Roll call vote in reverse order. So as soon as Senator Warner is here we will proceed. Mr. Sergeant-at-Arms, have you found Senator Warner? If you would please take your seats, we will go on to roll call now in reverse order and we are voting on the adoption of the Vickers amendment. Please hold your conversation down, which shouldn't be any, so that the Clerk may hear your response. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read the roll call vote as found on page 2240 of the Legislative Journal.) 22 ayes, 22 nays, Mr. President.
