SENATOR VICKERS: Mr. President, I would like to announce to the body that Nebraska, we just got word this afternoon, has been awarded a grant from the National Council of State Legislatures for an interim study proposal that we had provided to them and that I made a short trip to Washington to make a pitch for over the weekend and we were one of four states that were awarded this grant in competition with the other 49 states and I think Nebraska had ought to be rather proud of that. The study is going to be in a special committee for the oversight review of preschool special education since Nebraska is one of the national leaders in that particular area. I just thought it would be appropriate to bring it to your attention that Nebraska is going to get \$9500 as a result of that and to tell you that even though I wasn't successful in the first little venture this year that I went to Washington to maybe get some more money out of them, I was the second. So maybe you can thank me for that. Thank you, Mr. President.
