

emergency clause. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See pages 2264-65 of the Legislative Journal.) 27 ayes, 19 nays, 2 excused and not voting, 1 present and not voting on the bill with the emergency clause, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The bill passes without the emergency...no, the bill does not pass with the emergency clause. Now we will vote on whether the bill passes without the emergency clause.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator DeCamp would move to return the bill for specific amendment, the amendment being to strike the enacting clause.

SENATOR DECAMP: Mr. President, I was going to say it should pass with the emergency clause or not at all. It has not passed with the emergency clause and I don't know what confusion it creates if it passes without it but I will withdraw my motion. I just wanted to make that point.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is, shall the bill pass without the emergency clause? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See pages 2265-66 of the Legislative Journal.) 25 ayes, 20 nays, Mr. President, on the passage of the bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The bill passes without the emergency clause. LB 271A.

CLERK: (Read LB 271A on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: (Read record vote as found on page 2266 of the Legislative Journal.) 26 ayes, 14 nays, Mr. President, 2 excused and not voting, 7 present and not voting.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The bill passes. LB 273.
