SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay, the question is, shall the house go under...just a roll call vote? Okay. But some are not in their seats.

SENATOR GOODRICH: We better check in then and have a roll call vote.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Please check in and show your presence. Some have strayed from the fold, I'm afraid. We're looking for Senator Chizek, Senator Pirsch, Senator Beutler, Senator Hoagland, Senator Landis, Senator Hall. Mr. Clerk, Senator Vickers, Senator Beutler. We're looking for Senator Pirsch, Senator Chambers, Senator Beutler and Senator Vickers. Please record your presence as you come in. Senator Goodrich, Senator Chambers and Senator Pirsch are the two we are waiting for. Do you want to proceed? Roll call vote on, shall the bill be returned for the Goodrich amendment? Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 2267 of the Legislative Journal.) 22 ayes, 16 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to return the bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The motion fails. Anything else on the bill?

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Would you like to read the bill.

CLERK: (LB 273 read on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See page 2269 of the Legislative Journal.) 39 ayes, 7 nays, 3 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The bill passes. I'd like to introduce some guests, in the south balcony, of Senator Richard Peterson. There are 43 fourth graders from Christ Lutheran School in Norfolk, Nebraska, accompanied by their teachers. Would you folks stand and be recognized by the Legislature.
