

width term of the permit whether they could be prosecuted for a Class III misdemeanor as violating Section 1. I don't think that they could be. So what my amendment does is say that they could be. If they violate the terms of their permit, that also is a Class III misdemeanor. Now there are other sections of this particular statute that have specific provisions. For example, even if they get a permit, it says such vehicle shall travel at a speed which is not in excess of five miles per hour. Regardless of what kind of permit you have, you have to abide by that section...that part of Section 1 of the statute. That is clearly covered by the existing language and would continue to be covered by my amendment. But my amendment would expand the criminal penalty provision coverage to include the terms of a permit issued under Section 1. I would ask the adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is, shall the bill be returned? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

SPEAKER NICHOL: You've heard the motion. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. It is advanced. LB 102 with the emergency clause attached.
