

would have to re-vote, and if anybody else or any other city that was in operation would want to, they would have to come back and ask the state for permission similar to what Lincoln did on the city sales tax, the 1/2 percent increase. I ask for the adoption of these amendments.

PRESIDENT: Is there discussion on Senator Pappas's amendments to the committee amendments? Is there discussion? If not, the question is the adoption of the amendments. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. A simple majority. Please record your vote on the motion to adopt Senator Pappas's amendment to the committee amendments. Please record your vote. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 14 ayes, 4 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Pappas's amendment to the committee amendments.

PRESIDENT: The amendments to the committee amendments are adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the committee amendments, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Now the motion is on the committee amendments as amended, Senator Hefner's original motion. Do you wish to say anything further, Senator?

SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. President and members of the body, I move that we adopt the committee amendment to LB 144.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to adopt the committee amendments. Is there discussion? All right, all those in favor of adopting the committee amendments as amended vote aye, opposed vote nay. We are voting on the Miscellaneous Subjects Committee amendments as amended to LB 144. Please record your vote. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of committee amendments to the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Committee amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Pappas would now move to indefinitely postpone the bill.
