SENATOR VICKERS: Let's just have a call of the house. I would ask for a call of the house and a roll call vote, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay, the question is, shall the house go under call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 11 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay, the house is under call. Please record your presence. Those not in the Chamber, please return to the Chamber and record your presence promptly please. Most of you are here, so please record your presence. Senator Dan Lynch. Senator Vard Johnson, Senator Landis, Senator Morehead, Senator Beutler, Senator Chambers, Senator Pappas, Senator Scofield. Please remain in your seats. Senator Landis is the only one not here, Senator Vickers. May we proceed with roll call or do you want to wait for Senator Landis? Pardon me.

SENATOR VICKERS: Let's wait.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay. Senator Landis is here now. The question is, shall we reconsider the Vickers amendment, and if it receives 25 votes, then we will consider the Vickers amendment? So the question now is, shall the motion be reconsidered? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay and you asked for a roll call vote, didn't you, Senator Vickers? Mr. Clerk.
