

That is what 204A is all about. These are not those dollars. Now I don't understand that. All I am saying is we don't need that position. We don't need a coordinator to talk about the Old West Regional College of Veterinary Medicine any more, therefore, we don't need the \$139,980. I would ask for your vote to remove this from 722. Well, Mr. President, in order to save time, I am just going to ask for a call of the house to make sure everybody is here and then a roll call vote.

SPEAKER NICHOL: We are still under call.

SENATOR VICKERS: Then have everybody check in if you would please.

SPEAKER NICHOL: All right, would you please check your green button to make sure you are here. Please look up quickly. I think you are all here. Senator Wesely, Senator Rod Johnson, Senator Warner, Senator Smith, Senator Higgins, Senator Pappas, Senator Warner, Senator Landis, Senator Haberman, Senator Hall, Senator Schmit, and Senator Goodrich. Senator Warner, record your green light please. Senator Schmit, Senator Vard Johnson, and Senator Hall. Now we are looking for Senator Vard Johnson. Senator Vickers, Senator Vard Johnson is the only one not back. Do you wish to wait or continue with this, sir? He is here. You don't have to decide. The question is the adoption of the Vickers amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. He has requested a roll call vote so we will have a roll call on it. Mr. Clerk.
