SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is, shall the house go under call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 9 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The house is under call. Please record your presence. Those outside the Chamber, please return and record your presence. Unauthorized personnel, please leave the floor. Sergeant-at-Arms, those who are not here, please contact them and bring them into the fold. Senator DeCamp, will you take call ins. Then we are voting on the adoption of the DeCamp amendment to the Lynch-DeCamp amendment.

CLERK: Senator Schmit voting yes. Senator Rod Johnson voting yes.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Please record your presence. Senator Pirsch.

CLERK: Senator Pirsch voting yes.

SPEAKER NICHOL: We are voting on the adoption of the DeCamp amendment to the Lynch-DeCamp amendment. Call in votes are authorized.

CLERK: Senator Chizek voting yes. Senator Warner voting no. Senator Hannibal voting no. Senator Scofield voting no. Senator Rupp voting no. Senator Lowell Johnson voting no. Senator Lundy voting no. Senator Higgins voting yes. I got you, Senator Higgins. Senator Baack voting no. Senator Chambers voting yes.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 9 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay, the DeCamp amendment to the amendment is adopted. Now we are back on the Lynch-DeCamp amendment. Senator Wesely, did you wish to speak on this motion?

SENATOR WESELY: Yes, Mr. Speaker. I am sorry, did that amendment get adopted?
