SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER NICHOL: You are voting on the return of the bill for the Beutler amendment. Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: I think it is clear we are not going to get to Final Reading until we ask people to check in and have a roll call vote.

SPEAKER NICHOL: All right. Please record your presence. Please look up at the board. Please look up at the board. Ladies and gentlemen, please look up at the board. Thank you. Senator Lynch is the only one we are...and here he is. Did you request a roll call vote? Yes. We are voting for the return of the bill for the Beutler amendment. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 2365 of the Legislative Journal.) 22 ayes, 23 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The motion fails. Anything else?

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: I guess we are ready to read the bill, aren't we.

CLERK: (Read LB 401 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: (Read record vote as found on pages 2365-66 of the Legislative Journal.) 18 ayes, 26 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The bill fails, period. Do you have anything to put in, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, report of registered lobbyists for the week of May 9 through May 16.
