She didn't wait until the day after it was born and sent Senator Beutler out and said, run out and buy things for our child. All that is bought beforehand. The monthly cost of that, if you divide it by, say the six months, and incidentally, this pregnant woman will not be receiving that money for nine months. Usually it's, the average is six months because it is after she is determined pregnant and needs help. So it would be six months that she would be collecting that money and the monthly cost for those items which are just the bare minimum is \$58.11 a month. I know that each and every one of you that, even if you can't remember when your own child was born, the preparations you had to have. Certainly you do with your grandchildren because I know...when I know that I'm going to have another grandchild I'm out there buying things that are necessary for that child and in most cases, as Senator Morehead says, you can go to the emergency pregnancy service and get some of those items, but I've been to their store, the fact that they can't collect used items to give these pregnant women. Let me tell you that going to the abortion clinic on 49th and L, there are many, many women that have been turned away because the people that I'm working with will go there and say we can give you financial help. They don't even know that they're eligible for funds when they are going in that abortion clinic. We tell them they can get some money, we can help you, you can put your child up for adoption, don't enter the abortion clinic. I don't do it myself, I've never done it, but I've seen the other women that are there every time the clinic is open. On the day before Mother's Day there was 500 people, over 500, that marched almost a mile and a half in front of the abortion clinic with signs stating, we can help you, please do not abort your child. Now we're doing what we think will encourage them to do that because they have no one to turn to. I ask you not to do this. I ask you to vote for the kill motion and let's go on with cutting other programs and as I said before, I can't believe that we will put concrete, capital construction, roads, highways, universities, I could go on and name 102 of the 103 cuts that are proposed by the Governor, the Appropriations Committee and the so-called group and coalitions that we have going that say there are \$30 million worth of cuts. Certainly you're not going to start with the unborn child.
