SENATOR LABEDZ: Mr. Speaker...

SPEAKER NICHOL: Yes, Ma'am.

SENATOR LABEDZ: ...the unborn child is getting pretty close. I'll ask for a call of the house.

SPEAKER NICHOL: A call of the house has been called for. The question is, shall the house go under call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 15 ayes, 1 nay to go under call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The house is under call. Would you please record your presence. All those outside the Chamber, please return to the Chamber and record your presence. Unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Sergeant-at-Arms, please locate those who are not here. Please return to your desk promptly and record your presence. (Gavel.) Please return to your desk and record your presence. We're looking for Senator Abboud, Senator Landis, Senator Vickers. I guess we are all here, Senator Labeledz.

SENATOR LABEDZ: We'll have a roll call.

SPEAKER NICHOL: All right. The question is, shall the bill be indefinitely postponed? And Senator Labeledz has asked for a roll call vote. A simple majority.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken as found on page 2376 of the Legislative Journal.) 21 ayes, 21 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The motion fails.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay, we're back on the bill. Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move the bill be advanced.
