

SENATOR BEUTLER: Are there people missing?

SPEAKER NICHOL: Yes.

SENATOR BEUTLER: I'd ask that we go under call.

SPEAKER NICHOL: All right. The question is, shall the house go under call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 2 nays to go under call.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The house is under call. Please record your presence. Those outside the Chamber, please return to the Chamber to record your presence. While we are waiting for some to return, may I introduce some guests of Senator Vickers. In the south balcony we have 16 fourth graders from Beaver City Elementary School at Beaver City, Nebraska, accompanied by their teacher. Would all of you please stand and be recognized. Thank you. Senator Beutler, would you punch in, please? Now that is the extent of it. We are voting on the suspension of the rules. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 2378 of the Legislative Journal.) 29 ayes, 13 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The motion fails. Move on to LB 722. For those of you that may not have been here, I announced a little bit ago that we plan to go to about five-thirty, five forty-five, somewhere in there before we adjourn today. Thank you. The call is raised.

CLERK: Mr. President, the first item for consideration on 722 are the Appropriations Committee amendment 1414, amendment number 1414. Senator, you want me to identify those, or would...as we did yesterday, Mr. President, the following sections will be excepted from the committee amendment and voted on separately, Section 12, Section 22, Section 15, Section 40 and Section 39 will be separated from the committee amendments and voted on separately. Those are the only five that I have right now, Senator.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I move adoption of the balance of the proposed reductions. For those of you who wouldn't recognize the section number,
