The reductions proposed, there are several in number, \$30,000 legislative staff, that is the funding for full staffing year round. What it does reflect is what historically has been the case. The renovation fund of \$715,000 that we adopted one day. There is \$12,000 from policy research which is the staffing. There is \$46,000 for the Supreme Court which was two positions authorized but not filled. There is \$170,000 of county court special salary increase. In fact, we have consistently suggested all the special salary, and there were very few, would not be continued; \$50,000 in the Attorney General's office. There was \$100,000 appropriated for litigation regarding asbestos in state buildings. We feel with this amount left it perhaps will be adequate. Also we would reduce expert witness fund fee for the Attorney General's office from \$60,000 to \$30,000, an estimate of what might be needed. The Department of Education, there is \$100,000 reduction. Again, this is a special salary provision affecting visually handicapped and the school for the deaf. Instructional television was reduced by \$150,000; \$5,000 in the Public Service Commission for a micro computer. There is \$20,000 eliminated from the Department of Revenue, and these are some salary related adjustments, similar to the other things. The Department of Public Institutions is \$98,000 of general fund money which would have...was to have provided opening a new ward at Norfolk. That will be deferred; \$60,000...there was \$50,000 deleted from the Department of Social Services which was to provide five new protective service workers in that department. Originally it was proposed to have ten new ones, this was reduced to five new people because of increased work load. There is \$1 million reappropriation to Social Services of some anticipated unspent balances to offset general funds. This is one if it is done we'll add to next year's because it is one-time money. The Governor's Emergency Fund is reduced by \$130,000 from the level that had previously been anticipated to be used. Then there is the Nebraskaland Magazine, \$135,000 reduction from a \$276,000. The Nebraskaland Magazine can only be supported in part by cash funds. But a number of the types of articles included in that cannot be funded out of cash funds.
