SENATOR PIRSCH: This, again, is the committee amendment with which I have no opposition to. It makes the language a little bit clearer and easier to understand. I move its adoption.

SENATOR PIRSCH: This fourth committee amendment does strike the one year use of the advances by the law enforcement, and extends it to two years use. I, again, have no objection to that. The committee thought that since the first nine months, perhaps, may be in establishing ownership anyway that two years would be a more reasonable length of time for law enforcement to use it. I agree, so I move the committee amendment.
